ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE (AI) AND YOUR CHILD'S LEARNING

A GUIDE FOR PARENTS AND GUARDIANS IN NOVA SCOTIA

WHAT IS AI?
Artificial intelligence (AI) means computers that can learn from information and find patterns to help make decisions. AI doesn't think or feel like people - it uses data to make connections that help it answer our questions.

HOW IS AI USED IN SCHOOLS?
• Teachers choose if and how AI is used in the classroom.
• Some apps may include AI tools for learning or creativity.
• Students learn how to use technology safely and responsibly.

HOW AI CAN HELP LEARNING?
AI can help students in many ways:
• Give students quick feedback.
• Help with idea generation when a child is stuck.
• Offer support to different learning needs.
• Help students learn at their own pace.
Remember, teachers will always tell students when they can or cannot use AI for school work.

AI PRIVACY AND SAFETY TIPS:
• Never share personal info with AI tools.
• Only use apps approved by your school or regional centre.
• Look closely at the age restrictions of AI tools.
• Talk with your child about what you, what privacy, and what's not yours.

AT HOME YOU CAN HELP BY:
• Setting screen time limits and tech-free times.
• Talking about what your child sees online.
• Encouraging your child to check if AI answers make sense.
• Asking questions about the AI usage guidelines.
• Encouraging children to think critically about AI-generated content.
