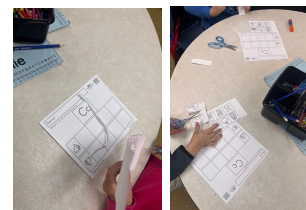

Order sheets have been sent home with all students and are due back by October 20th with cash or cheque payable to "Ross Road School".

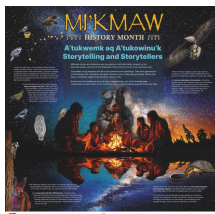
