### Do You Know How to Raise A Concern?

We want families to feel comfortable reaching out when they have questions or concerns about their child's education or well-being. In most cases, concerns can be resolved quickly by connecting directly with school staff.

If you do have a concern, start by speaking with your child's teacher or ECE. They are often best positioned to address questions about your child's learning or classroom experience. If the concern isn't resolved, contact the school principal to continue the conversation and work toward a solution. If you need additional support, HRCE's Family Navigators are here to help. They can provide guidance and connect families with helpful resources and supports. They can be reached at [connect@hrce.ca](mailto:connect@hrce.ca). If the concern still isn't resolved, a formal review process can be requested and the matter will be looked into by the appropriate HRCE Director. The final step is for the concern to be reviewed by the Regional Executive Director.
